## GENERAL INFORMATION

**\*AAC TRIAL RULES:** This sanctioned trial is being held under the rules of the AAC. All obstacles conform to AAC specifications. The trial is open to all dogs over 18 months of age. No bitches in season, dogs suffering from injuries, or dogs showing signs of aggressiveness will be permitted to run. In the spirit of sportsmanship and fairness to others, the disregard of AAC rules will be grounds for dismissal from the rest of the trial weekend and no entry fees will be refunded. As well a complete report will be forwarded to AAC for further disciplinary action. Pye K9 Kapers Agility Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.

**\*AAC ID NUMBER:** All dogs must be registered with AAC with a valid AAC number in order to compete in this trial. If your dog has a new Re-measurement AAC card we can provide a measurement for the new 2018 jump heights.

**\*JUNIOR HANDLING:** A Junior Handler class will be offered at this trial. Junior handlers must apply to AAC for a number. Forms are available on the AAC website.

**\*WARM UP AREA:** a warm up area, as required by the AAC, will be provided.

**\*DEADLINE AND CHANGES:** No entries will be accepted, changed, withdrawn after the closing date, with the exception of 1) Dogs may move up to the next class by informing the secretary prior to the trial. 2) Bitches in season or dogs who have been injured after the closing date may request a refund upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate.

**\*RING READY:** Exhibitors are responsible to check the running order posted by the ring and be on deck and ready to run. Failure to do so may cause you to lose your turn.

**\*EQUIPMENT:** Electronic time, a breakaway tire, and rubberized contacts will be used at this trial.

**\*CONFIRMATION:** Confirmation will be sent out by email after the closing date.

**\*MOVE UPS:** Move ups are allowed at this trial. Move up form will be located outside scoring trailer. Fill out information and all updates will be recorded at the end of each day.

**\*ACCOMMODATIONS:** There will be **dry camping** available on site, with no electrical hookup. Please let us know if you plan to camp on site.

**Riverside Resort & Conference Centre:** 35 Mactaquac Road, Fredericton, NB, E3E 1L2. About 4 km from site. Special rate of \$89/night for our trial!! Mention **K9 Kapers group rate** when booking room.

**Mactaquac Provincial Park** is about 5 KM from site on Hwy 105.

**Woolastook Campground** is about 8 KM from site.

**Prospect Inn** 1600 Woodstock Rd, Fredericton, NB E3C 1P3. About 17 km from site.

## DIRECTIONS TO FIELD:

Travelling west on Hwy 2 take exit 281. (Hanwell Road). Turn left on Hanwell Rd and go past Tim Horton's on your right. At the next set of lights turn left on Prospect Street. This will turn into Hwy 102. Travel 12 km on Hwy 102 and you will come to the Keswick Ridge/Mactaquac exit. (there is no exit number) Take that exit and keep to your right. You will see Riverside Resort & Conference Centre on your left. Travel across dam and take the first right after the dam. This is Hwy 105. Travel about 4 km on Hwy 105 and you will pass Crocks Point Rd on right and Route 616 on your left. Just past this intersection is our field. We will have signs out.

Travelling East on Hwy 2 take exit 258. Follow signs to Fredericton and Mactaquac. Travel about 12 km to the Keswick Ridge and Mactaquac exit. (no exit number) From there follow directions above.

## AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

- STARTERS:** Open to dogs that have not earned a Starters title.
- ADVANCED:** Open to dogs that have earned a Starters title, but have not earned an Advanced title.
- MASTERS:** Open to dogs that have earned an Advanced title.
- REGULAR:** Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC.
- SPECIALS:** Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights will be as per AAC rules.
- VETERANS:** For dogs 7 years of age or older, in the case of dogs currently competing in any Regular Agility class. This class shall also be for dogs 5 years of age or older who have been competing in Specials for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in the Regular classes once entered in an official trial in any of the Veteran classes. Course times and jump heights will be per AAC rules.
- FEO:** For Exhibition Only. Competitors are offered the option to enter classes "for exhibition only". FEO entries are not eligible to "Q" nor are they eligible for placements. FEO entries will not be judged. FEO participants must have an AAC number in order to enter.

**Please note: In order to offer all competitors a smooth running, relaxing trial, all entrants will be expected to volunteer. We ask everyone to indicate what job they would like to do. If not indicated, we will assign you a suitable spot.**

**\*\* Notice to all Youth and Student Handlers:** To promote the sport of agility to all younger handlers, we are offering a reduced fee for all runs. Fees for student handlers, regardless of age, will be **\$10.00**. For our Junior Handlers we are offering **\$8.00** per run.
